- Please be aware that the below are just **suggested activities** and have been given to assist in structuring the girls' day.

Suggested Activities

Maths:

- This week, the girls can take a look at the Mental Maths section of their Planet Maths Book. There are 10 Mental Maths pages in their book. I am aware some of the girls will have completed a couple of these pages in school, therefore the weekly schedule may not apply below. Try to attempt one mental maths page a day.
- Ask the girls to attempt the 10 problems on their own at first and circle the questions they are having difficulties with. They could then revisit the problem with a parent to see if they can solve the problem. Finally, count the number of correct answers & give a score /10.
- I have selected one problem-solving page a day as follows (If the girls have completed Mental Maths 1 already, then attempt Mental Maths 2 & so forth:
- Monday May 18th: Mental Maths 1 p28
- Tuesday May 19th: Mental Maths 2 p40
- Wednesday May 20th: Mental Maths 3 p53
- Thursday May 21st: Mental Maths 4 p71
- Friday May 22nd: Mental Maths 5 p88

(Mental Maths 6 p108, Mental Maths 7 p125, Mental Maths 8 p141, Mental Maths 9 p155, Mental Maths 10 p156)
