

# Junior Infants

Suggestions for work that your child could complete at home: Twinkl.

Twinkl has a wide variety of different materials to aid learning across all subject areas. Setting this up is really easy to do- go to [www.twinkl.ie/offer](http://www.twinkl.ie/offer) and enter the code **IRLTWINKLHELPS** to set up your free account. There is a **Junior Infants Class pack**. If possible download, print and complete.

1. Maths - counting 1-20, forwards and backwards. Start at different numbers and count on/count back. Sing number rhymes and songs all on YouTube. Practice writing numbers 1,2,3,4,5. Sorting- sort colors, toys, clothes etc all into sets. Name and draw shapes- circle, square, triangle, rectangle. Sing days of the week and months of the year songs, The big number song on YouTube.
- English.  
Read stories, ask questions- what happened, why, when, where, how do you know, what's going to

happen next.

Practice writing all letters and name each sound.

Write and read simple three letter words eg-

cat,man,tin,fox

Write and

read simple sentences 'I can run.' , ' Here is a cat.'

Use play dough to make letters and words.

YouTube- The tricky words song. Gaeilge.

Name body parts, clothes, food, weather- in Irish.

Sing songs and say Irish poems.

sing nursery rhymes, bake, practice cutting,
