Tuesday

<u>English</u>	Listen to the sounds song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=T4lfiKiQ-3I . Write the letters s,a,t,i,p,n.
<u>Maths</u>	Counting 1-10, 10-1, Count at different starts 3-10, 5-10. Say a number and ask your child what number comes next. Write numerals 1,2,3,4,5
<u>Gaeilge</u>	Sing the song Rolaí Polaí https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=q5KxTACF3cM . Lámh lámh eile
<u>Cutting</u>	Use a piece of paper and cut straight, curvy, zig- zag lines.

Wednesday

English	Listen to "The Tricky Word" song on YouTube https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TvMyssfAUx0 . Practise writing the words I, the, to, go, no, he she, we
Maths	Make a pattern with household items. Eg. Spoons and forks.
Play	Play I spy/ board game/card game/ jigsaw
SESE	Place some random objects into a bag and ask your child to put their hand in and try to guess what the object is by feeling it (is it rough, smooth, soft, spiky etc. as prompting questions)

Thursday

English	Shared Reading- Choose any book to read together and stop every now and again if you think there is a word that she could blend or a Tricky Word she might recognise.
Maths	Draw a circle and a square, colour, triangle and rectangle
Yoga	Cosmic kids Yoga on YouTube
Art	"Take a line for a walk" - give your child a blank A4 page and ask her to take a line for a walk all around the page without lifting the pencil off the page at any time. Colour in the different loops/sections that they've created.

Friday

English	Oral Language "I am grateful for _____" Take turns! Storytime. Listen to the story of The little red hen on YouTube.
Maths	Go on a shape hunt around the house.
Music	Practise nursery Rhymes- Hey Diddle Diddle, Humpty Dumpty, Baa Baa Black Sheep. Sing the song - "Five little ducks" click on link to YouTube https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=pZw9veQ76fo Teddy Bears Picnic- https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=YDndFOtBy-E
PE	Have a Dance Party to "Dance Monkey" Pause the song and play musical statues
