- I know I have previously sent out work packs for the next 2 weeks and the girls may be still working on them. This is perfectly fine and the children can continue to do so for the next fortnight.
- Some children may have also worked through the Easter holidays and might have finished up all their work already, therefore I have included some additional exercises that could be completed below as I know the girls in Room 8 love to be kept busy!

Suggested Activities

1. Maths:

- This week, the RTE school hub will be covering a **Data** lesson on **Thursday 23rd April at 11 a.m on RTE2.**
- The children could complete the Data chapter in their Planet Maths Books p146-149.
- Tuesday 21st April: p146- (For Exercise C-try draw out 20 colored dots on a page if beads are not available.)

2. Geography:

- This week, the RTE school hub will be covering geography lesson on the **counties & provinces of Ireland on Tuesday 21st April from 11 a.m.**
- The children could research a county of their choice and create a mini project.
- The children could research: 1. The name of the county (in English & Irish) 2. Draw the county flag, 3. Which province is it in? 4. How many people live there? 5. What is the main county town? 6. Does this county have any

rivers/mountains? 7. Do any famous people come from this county? 8. Draw a famous landmark from the county. 9. What is the county's car registration? 10. What counties are beside this county?

3. Art:

- I have included a 45 minute art lesson called "Fancy Fox". The art lesson can be found by copying the link below or typing "Fancy Fox deep space sparkle" into Youtube. The lesson only requires a pencil & some colouring pencils/markers.

- The girl's has been reading the novel "Fantastic Mr Fox" by Roald Dahl so this art lesson would link in well with that.

4. English

- Please continue to work on the reading comprehensions that were given out as part of the work packs in March.
- If you have access to an electronic device & internet- the Twinkl website has a wealth of resources aimed at 1st & 2nd class level. The girls could access audio books to listen to and there are a range of reading comprehensions & cloze procedures (fill in the blanks) that could be printed off or transcribed.
- To access the site for free, simply follow the steps below:
- **Step 1: Go to www.twinkl.ie/offer**
- **Step 2: Enter the code IRLTWINKLHELPS, along with your email address and a password (as a new user)**
- **Step 3: Click on the 1st/2nd link and then on "English-Reading" from the pop-up menu. There are a range of additional resources to be accessed there.**

5. Gaeilge

- Watch RTE's School Hub from Monday (April 20th). This can be accessed on the RTE Player online or if you have "On Demand" on your television.
- The first 20 minutes of the episode deals with "Eadaí-Clothes" which the girls have covered in school already. This could be used as a little bit of revision.
