

# Senior Infants

Suggestions for work that your child could complete at home:

- Twinkl has a wide variety of different materials to aid learning across all subject areas. Setting this up is really easy to do- go to [www.twinkl.ie/offer](http://www.twinkl.ie/offer) and enter the code **IRLTWINKLHELPS** to set up your free account. There is a **Junior Infants Class pack**. If possible download, print and complete.
- **MATHS:**
  - Counting forwards 0-20 (also starting at different numbers)
  - Counting backwards from 20 (also starting at different numbers)
  - Saying and writing numbers before/after
  - Making sets and counting items around the house.
  - Finding 2D and 3D shapes around the house (draw pictures of the things they find)

- Maths Hunt around the house e.g. how many doors are downstairs? How many steps on stairs? How many chairs in house? How many legs on all the chairs? Who is youngest/tallest/smallest/oldest/shortest in house?
- Arrange toys in order of height/length
- Practice writing numbers 1-10
- Draw sets 1-10
- Write simple number sentences ( $3+5=?$ ) Draw a picture or use some counters to find the answers

## **ENGLISH:**

- Practice Jolly Phonics sounds along with songs and actions (can be found on YouTube)
- Write some simple sentences. Say the sentence orally a few times using different voices. Count how many words are in the sentence. Sound out any words they may find

difficult. Write the sentence. Remind child to use Capital letter at the start. Finger space between words and full stop at end of sentence.

- Practice writing sight words - click on link [Sight Words](#) [Sight Words 2](#)
- Make up your own story and make a book - draw pictures and write simple sentences to match pictures.
- Write a report about your favourite animal.
- The Following books can be found on YouTube, read and watch them together. Children can draw a picture of the characters and setting of the stories. Label the pictures. Children can also draw 3 large boxes on a page. Box 1 = First Box 2 = Next and Box 3 = Last. Children can draw a picture for each part of the story and write a sentence to match.
